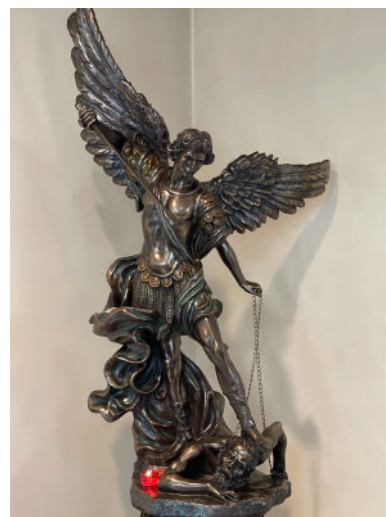

## Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

- Acts 10:34a, 37-43** We ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.
- Psalm 118** "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad."
- Colossians 3:1-4 or 1 Cor 5:6b-8** Seek what is above, where Christ is. Clear out the old yeast, so that you may become a fresh batch of dough.
- John 20:1-9** He had to rise from the dead. Through the gift of God's word, we get to hear how the Resurrection event gradually came to be understood by the early disciples. In the first two readings, Peter and Paul speak of how our life has completely changed because Jesus Christ was raised from the dead. We may receive forgiveness of sins in his name. We now seek what is above, our destiny. We have become a fresh batch of dough in the hands of the Lord. But upon first seeing the empty tomb, neither Mary Magdalene, Peter, nor John understands what happened. However, even then, a glimmer of faith was kindled.
