## Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Exodus 12:1-8, 11-14

**Psalm 116** 

The Passover is here: Slaughter the lamb during the evening twilight.

"Our blessing-cup is a communion with the Blood of Christ."

1 Corinthians 11:23-26 Jesus said: Do this in remembrance of me. John 13:1-15 Jesus said: As I have done, so you must do.

Tonight's readings naturally intertwine, since each describes the memorial meal that has become the one we celebrate tonight and every time we gather to celebrate the Eucharist. We hear God's instructions for the Passover meal, which ensure that the angel of death will pass over the homes of the Chosen People that night. We sing of the cup of salvation, which unites us with Christ's sacrifice. We listen to the earliest written account of the first Eucharist, from Paul's letter to the Christian community in Corinth. Finally, we hear John's account of Jesus' dramatic action, which leaves his disciples a model to follow as they continue his mission. May the words we hear tonight, these many generations later, inspire us as we ourselves receive the Lord.



- On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent: Everyone ages 14 and up must abstain from eating meat.
- On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday: Everyone ages 18 to 59 must fast, unless exempt due to a medical reason. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.
