

In this difficult and sacred day, the scriptural passages we hear bring our Lord's suffering and death into focus. Isaiah describes the scapegoat of a sinful people, the blameless one who takes on the sins of the people and whose suffering brings forgiveness to the community. The scapegoat, the sacrificial lamb, the Lamb of God, sacrifices his body and commends his spirit into the hands of God. Hebrews celebrates that Christ, the high priest, was tested just like we are, yet remained sinless and is now the source of our salvation. John's account of Jesus' passion and death emphasizes the obedience and steadfastness of our Lord in testifying to the truth and accomplishing his mission. Listening to the word of God, let us appreciate the resolve of him who sets us free from sin and death.




