## Introduction to the Liturgy of the Word

Acts 10:34a, 37–43 Peter is an eyewitness: The Lord is risen.

"This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice **Psalm 118** 

and be glad."

All who are baptized, set your hearts in heaven. Colossians 3:1–4 John 20:1-9

Three witnesses, Mary, Peter, and John, respond

to the empty tomb.

The readings we hear today celebrate the Lord's resurrection. Saints Peter and Paul bring the good news of the Resurrection to the Gentiles. Peter gives eyewitness testimony of his time with Jesus before and after his death and resurrection, while Paul points out that the Resurrection transforms our lives. In the Gospel, neither angels nor the risen Lord appear to the first visitors to the tomb to testify to the Resurrection, but the disciple Jesus loves believes at once. May God's word guide us to belief as well.


